 - a. Kingsfleet Phase 1b approved subject to conditions and approval by Highways.
 - b. A Landlord Webinar to take place on 24th March at 6pm which will include changes to legislation.
 - c. Parish Councils cannot apply for a Jubilee Grant but Community Groups are, such as the Village Hall.
 - d. On 17th March a Future Thetford Workshop will take place at the Guildhall.
 - e. Fly-tipping an ongoing issue.
- iii. **GTP** The following was reported:
 - a. The Economy and Growth Team did a presentation regarding the plans and consultation proposals regarding the future Breckland. A draft plan to be issued by the end of May, however, not much detail provided.
 - b. There is a study currently being carried out on the Little Ouse and ways to connect Thetford to Brandon via waterways and cycling paths.
 - c. SUE: various questions were raised on:
 - i. EV charging points
 - ii. Street lighting apparently are no longer part of Breckland's policy.
 - iii. School trigger has been hit but no further development as currently there is no need as a large number of children currently attend school outside of Thetford.
